In accordance with the Association's rules, please read the reverse of this form so that you are aware of your financial obligations arising from membership and the circumstances and manner in which you may resign from membership.

FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS:

7. Every Member owning stock shall pay an annual contribution on the basis of the rate determined annually by the Council according to the estimated administrative requirements for the then current year, the maximum rate so struck not to exceed the following scale.
 - Minimum Membership for owners of livestock be capped at \$160.00 **including GST**
 - Owners of stock shall pay to a maximum rate of \$8.00 **including GST** per 100 sheep equivalent up to 10,000 maximum sheep equivalent.
 - Owners of cattle shall pay on the basis that one head of cattle is equivalent to six sheep.
 - Owners of farmed goats shall pay on the basis of one goat is equivalent to one sheep.

- 7A. Any person owning stock who is admitted as a Member after the 30th June in any one year shall pay a contribution of **50 per cent** of the assessed annual rate **including GST** for the year in question.

8. Each member may fill in a stock return as provided by the Association not later than the 31st December in each year stating the number of stock owned. Such returns shall form the basis for assessing the contribution payable for membership. Members have the option of not furnishing a stock return and membership will be calculated on one sheep equivalent to 5 hectares to a maximum of 10,000 sheep equivalent.

9. A Member shall register with the Association from time to time all properties owned or occupied by him within the territory of the Association, and shall pay the prescribed contribution in respect of each of such properties.

12. Every Member shall pay his contribution at the office of the Association.

13. The Association may sue or take any other proceedings either at law or in equity in the name of its Administration Officer for the time being against any of its Members in or about any matter or thing respecting which the Association may have sued or taken proceedings if it had been duly incorporated, including the enforcement of payment by Members of calls and contributions.

RESIGNATIONS:

16. A member of the Association may resign from Membership by written notice and delivered to the Administration Officer of the Association.

Such notice delivered to the Administration Officer, shall be taken to have been received by the Association when it was delivered.

A notice of resignation that has been received by the Association shall not be deemed invalid if it was not addressed and delivered in accordance with the above.

- 16A Notice of resignation from membership of the Association shall take effect

- (a) At the end of three months after the notice has been received by the Association, or on the day specified in the notice, whichever is later; or,
- (b) Where a Member ceases to be eligible to become a Member of the Association:
 - (i) On the day on which the notice is received by the Association:
or,
 - (ii) On the day specified in the notice, which is a day not earlier than the day when the Member ceases to be eligible to become a Member;

Whichever is the later; whereupon, the Member shall cease to have any interest in or claim upon the Funds of the Association, but shall remain indebted to the Association for all contributions and other sums due by him to the Association at the date when his resignation takes effect and may be sued for such sums due in the name of the Association, in a court of competent jurisdiction, as a debt due to the Association.
